We are in Italy:

Sometimes routes will be effected by shop owners/occasional technical problems. In such cases we will do our absolute best to serve something of equal or higher deliciousness.

HEALTH AND SAFETY:

Any guest with food allergies or intollerances is responsible for communicating this information in advance to **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** so we can best prepare your tastings. **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** takes every precaution to order said tastings through our venues. However, **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** cannot be held liable for indiscrepancies made by the venues we visit for tastings. Any guest with mortal food allergies is asked to carry proper medication with them. By reserving with **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA**, the guest agrees to carry proper medication at all times while in the company of **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA**. By reserving, guest agrees that **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** cannot be held liable for indiscrepancies made by the venues we visit for tastings.

OUR RESPONSIBILITY:

Responsibilities and Tour Conditions for **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA**, also referred to as “the Operator”. Any person reserving or purchasing any **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** tour accepts the condition that the Operator reserves to itself the exclusive right to change or cancel itineraries and other tour components if necessary, when necessary. Should this happen, **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** will make every effort to offer alternate dates and/or programs. Times listed on itineraries are as accurate as possible but subject to change due to traffic, weather, mechanical and any other conditions beyond the Operator's control that prevent **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** from operating as scheduled. **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** expressly

disclaims any liability for any damages that may be incurred for any changes, cancellations, or delays in any itinerary.

OUR LIABILITY:

DELICIOUS BOLOGNA provides a service to travellers. Our service is a liaison between said travellers and local merchants, restaurants and other venues.

DELICIOUS BOLOGNA, therefore, shall not be responsible for breach of contract or any intentional or careless actions or omissions on part of such suppliers, which result in any loss, damage, delay, or injury to you or your travel companions or group members.

Unless the term "guaranteed" is specifically stated in writing on your ticket, invoice, or reservation itinerary, the **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** does not guarantee any of such suppliers' scheduling, behavior or handling of personal effects.

DELICIOUS BOLOGNA shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages, or losses caused to any traveler in connection with terrorist activities, social, or labor unrest, mechanical or construction failures or difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, criminal acts or abnormal conditions or developments, or any other actions, omissions, or conditions outside the control of **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA**.

Travelers are responsible for themselves and are expected not to break or damage anything belonging to the venues visited on the tour. Anything broken by a guest due to negligence will require payment or replacement by said guest.

PRIVACY POLICY:

DELICIOUS BOLOGNA collects, uses and protects the personal information you provide to us on our website, and in email correspondence. **DELICIOUS BOLOGNA** will only collect and use your personal information for purposes of booking tours that you have

expressly requested. In order to purchase our products or services, it is necessary for you to disclose personal information, including but not limited to your name, email address, phone number (optional), and credit card details in order to process orders and provide customer service. We cannot confirm your booking if you do not furnish the requested information when buying one of our tours or services. In some instances we may also ask for personal demographic data such as your country of residence, gender, age, travel habits, etc.

We do not use cookies to identify specific users for marketing purposes.

HOW *DELICIOUS BOLOGNA* USES YOUR PERSONAL DATA:

- To provide the information you request about our services
- To fulfill your bookings
- To confirm your purchases
- To ensure you are correctly billed
- To send you follow-up questionnaires and gift vouchers

Unless you expressly authorize us to do so, we do not share your personal information with third-party organizations that are not involved in fulfilling the purchases you have made from *DELICIOUS BOLOGNA*.

We do not collect personally identifiable information through the Site unless that information is provided by you during registration for various features on the Site. Information required to participate in such features may vary but will typically include your first and last name; address including city, state, zip code and country; daytime and evening phone numbers; and e-mail address.

Like most websites, the Site also collects information automatically and through the use of electronic tools that may be transparent to our visitors. For example, we may log the name of your Internet Service Provider or use “cookie” technology.

In certain cases, you can choose not to provide us with information, for example by setting your browser to refuse to accept cookies, but doing so may limit your ability to access certain portions of the Site

What we do with the information we collect. We will use your information only as permitted by law. Information that does not personally identify you (“Aggregated Information”) may be used in various ways. For example, we may combine information about your usage patterns with similar information obtained from other users to learn which Site pages are visited most or what features of the Site are most attractive. Aggregated Information may be shared with our advertisers and business partners, but cannot be used to contact you individually.
